Paper botanist Ling Warlow creates extraordinary flowers using paper, wire and glue.

Ling creates plants and flowers, large and small, as props for film and photoshoots. Focussing on British Wildflowers, her sculptural botanical art is incredibly detailed.

Ling's creative practice embraces sustainability through both natural colour, dyeing her papers using found and foraged ingredients, and being plastic free.

Ling's work has been commissioned by ITV and featured by National Museums Liverpool. Her work has been used by acclaimed stylists and award winning creative directors on film and photographic projects. It was also published in BRAND YOU magazine.

Ling was given a solo exhibition for five weeks at World Museum Liverpool featuring 'Nature's Palette', a project celebrating diversity for Eurovision2023 with the national flowers of all competing countries created from paper Ling coloured with natural dye.

As an artist and educator Ling uses the craft of paper flower making as a vehicle to encourage a connection to nature. She has worked in schools and community groups and delivers private workshops to small groups.
